

Seneca School

As part of the Seneca History Project, the students have completed 20 interviews and articles. Seven articles are posted at www.oregongreengold.com/SenecaProject/SenecaSchoolHome.html.

The Ford Family Foundation grant paid for a second year of the artist-in-residence program for the school, bringing a presenter on international folk dances, a community workshop and performance to the school.

Each class took its role as community members seriously through projects, such as repainting fire hydrants, conducting story time for preschoolers, making a new drug-free “Hands” wall for the city park and cleaning Bear Valley Meadows golf course.

The seventh- and eighth-graders participated in peer mediation training and have had several opportunities to use it.

Principal Adele Cerny told the board the Seneca PTA helped install new sinks and counters at the school, noting the 1930’s sink they used to have is on its way out.
